#### **Ecclesiastes 1:1-14 NIV**

## **Everything Is Meaningless**

- 1 The words of the Teacher, [a] son of David, king in Jerusalem:
- <sup>2</sup> "Meaningless! Meaningless!" says the Teacher.
- "Utterly meaningless! Everything is meaningless."
- <sup>3</sup> What do people gain from all their labors at which they toil under the sun?
- <sup>4</sup>Generations come and generations go, but the earth remains forever.
- <sup>5</sup> The sun rises and the sun sets, and hurries back to where it rises.
- <sup>6</sup> The wind blows to the south and turns to the north; round and round it goes, ever returning on its course.
- <sup>7</sup> All streams flow into the sea, yet the sea is never full. To the place the streams come from, there they return again.
- <sup>8</sup> All things are wearisome, more than one can say. The eye never has enough of seeing, nor the ear its fill of hearing.
- <sup>9</sup> What has been will be again, what has been done will be done again; there is nothing new under the sun.
- <sup>10</sup> Is there anything of which one can say, "Look! This is something new"? It was here already, long ago; it was here before our time.
- <sup>11</sup> **No one remembers the former generations**, and even those yet to come will not be remembered by those who follow them.

#### Wisdom Is Meaningless

<sup>12</sup> I, the Teacher, was king over Israel in Jerusalem. <sup>13</sup> I applied my mind to study and to explore by wisdom all that is done under the heavens. What a heavy burden God has laid on mankind! <sup>14</sup> I have seen all the things that are done under the sun; *all of them are meaningless, a chasing after the wind*.

### A Time for Everything

- 3 There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens:
- a time to be born and a time to die, a time to plant and a time to uproot,
- a time to kill and a time to heal, a time to tear down and a time to build,
- a time to weep and a time to laugh, a time to mourn and a time to dance,
- a time to scatter stones and a time to gather them, a time to embrace and a time to refrain from embracing,
- a time to search and a time to give up, a time to keep and a time to throw away,
- a time to tear and a time to mend, a time to be silent and a time to speak,
- <sup>8</sup> a time to love and a time to hate, a time for war and a time for peace.
- <sup>9</sup> What do workers gain from their toil? <sup>10</sup> I have seen the burden God has laid on the human race. <sup>11</sup> **He** has made everything beautiful in its time. He has also set eternity in the human heart; yet<sup>[a]</sup> no one can

fathom what God has done from beginning to end. <sup>12</sup> I know that there is *nothing better for people than to be happy and to do good while they live*. <sup>13</sup> That each of them may *eat and drink, and find satisfaction in all their toil—this is the gift of God.* <sup>14</sup> I know that everything God does will endure forever; nothing can be added to it and nothing taken from it. God does it so that people will fear him.

Whatever is has already been, and what will be has been before; and God will call the past to account.

<sup>16</sup> And I saw something else under the sun: In the place of judgment—wickedness was there, in the place of justice—wickedness was there.

<sup>17</sup>I said to myself, "God will bring into judgment both the righteous and the wicked, *for there will be a time for every activity, a time to judge every deed.*"

<sup>18</sup>I also said to myself, "As for humans, God tests them so that they may see that they are like the animals.

<sup>19</sup> Surely the fate of human beings is like that of the animals; **the same fate awaits them both**: As one dies, so dies the other. All have the same breath<sup>[c]</sup>; humans have no advantage over animals. Everything is meaningless. <sup>20</sup> All go to the same place; all come from dust, and to dust all return. <sup>21</sup> Who knows if the human spirit rises upward and if the spirit of the animal goes down into the earth?"

<sup>22</sup> So I saw that there is nothing better for a person than to enjoy their work, because that is their lot. For who can bring them to see what will happen after them?
