#### The Fellowship of the Believers

<sup>42</sup> They *devoted themselves* to the apostles' *teaching* and to *fellowship*, to the *breaking of bread* and to *prayer*.
 <sup>43</sup> Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles. <sup>44</sup> All the believers were together and had everything in common. <sup>45</sup> They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need.
 <sup>46</sup> Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, <sup>47</sup> praising God and *enjoying the favor of all the people*. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

#### The Way of the Master...

#### 1 Peter 1:13-2:3 NIV

#### Be Holy

<sup>13</sup> Therefore, with minds that are alert and fully sober, set your hope on the grace to be brought to you when Jesus Christ is revealed at his coming. <sup>14</sup> As obedient children, do not conform to the evil desires you had when you lived in ignorance. <sup>15</sup> But just as he who called you is holy, **so be holy in all you do**; <sup>16</sup> for it is written: "Be holy, because I am holy."

<sup>17</sup> Since you call on a Father who judges each person's work impartially, live out your time as foreigners here in reverent fear. <sup>18</sup> For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your ancestors, <sup>19</sup> but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect. <sup>20</sup> He was chosen before the creation of the world, but was revealed in these last times for your sake. <sup>21</sup> Through him you believe in God, who raised him from the dead and glorified him, and so your faith and hope are in God.

<sup>22</sup> Now that you have purified yourselves by obeying the truth so that you have sincere love for each other, love one another deeply, from the heart. <sup>23</sup> For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God. <sup>24</sup> For,

"All people are like grass, and all their glory is like the flowers of the field; the grass withers and the flowers fall, <sup>25</sup> but the word of the Lord endures forever."

And this is the word that was preached to you.

2 Therefore, *rid yourselves of all malice and all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and slander of every kind.* <sup>2</sup> *Like newborn babies, crave pure spiritual milk*, so that by it you may grow up in your salvation, <sup>3</sup> now that you have tasted that the Lord is good.

#### Becoming what and who you were created to be... John 15:5-8 NIV

<sup>5</sup> "I am the vine; you are the branches. *If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.* <sup>6</sup> If you do not remain in me, you are like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned. <sup>7</sup> If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. <sup>8</sup> *This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples.*

"Lord Jesus, I need You. Thank You dying on the cross and taking the punishment for my sins. I open the door of my life to you and receive You as my Lord and Saviour.
