¹³ "You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled underfoot.

¹⁴ "You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. ¹⁵ Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. ¹² Therefore, my dear friends, as you have always obeyed—not only in my presence, but now much more in my absence—continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling, ¹³ *for it is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfill his good purpose.*

¹⁴ **Do everything without grumbling or arguing**, ¹⁵ so that you may become blameless and pure, "children of God without fault in a warped and crooked generation." ^[c] **Then you will shine among them like stars in the sky** ¹⁶ as you **hold firmly to the word of life**.

More Than Conquerors

³¹ What, then, shall we say in response to these things? *If God is for us, who can be against us?* ³² He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—*how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?* ³³ Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen? It is God who justifies. ³⁴ Who then is the one who condemns? No one. Christ Jesus who died—more than that, who was raised to life—is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us. ³⁵ Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? ³⁶ As it is written:

"For your sake we face death all day long; we are considered as sheep to be slaughtered." [1]

³⁷ No, *in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.* ³⁸ For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, ^[k] neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, ³⁹ neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

- Bad things happen to people (In this world you will have trouble... John 16:33)
- Our experiences, birthplace, hurts, disappointments, rejections, losses, mistakes, parents, children, family, workplace, government, media and ALL our injustices do not need to define us! They may shape us to a degree, but they do not need to define our thinking, actions or our future.
